SPONSORS ARE REMINDED THAT ANY PROCESSION, PARADE OR OTHER IMPEDANCE ON A STATE-OWNED PORTION OF A STATE HIGHWAY, REQUIRES AN ADDITIONAL PERMIT UNDER CHAPTER 81, SECTION 21 OF THE GENERAL LAWS, ISSUED BY THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ENGINEER, MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, ARLINGTON, MASSACHUSETTS.

BY ORDERS OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE: In accordance with Article II, Section 2 of the TRAFFIC RULES AND ORDERS OF THE TOWN OF HOLLISTON, Permission is hereby granted to hold a parade, procession or similar assemblage as described above, and to have streets and traffic blocked incidental thereto subject to the terms and conditions following:

1. Acceptance of this Permit is an explicit agreement to abide by the terms thereof and to accept the responsibilities and liabilities stated herein.
2. The holder of this Permit shall notify the Fire Chief of the Town of Holliston not less than 48 hours prior to the commencement of the event.
3. Sufficient uniformed police warranted to man detours and control motor and pedestrian traffic should be present to affect the minimum delay to motorist and the safety of the spectators at no expense to the Town. Examination of the application by the Safety Officer has determined that this number shall not be less than \_\_\_\_\_.
4. Detours and alternate routes shall be capable of handling the average hourly volume of traffic for that time and place as determined by the Safety Officer.
5. The holder of this Permit shall furnish all signs, barriers and other controls needed to effect detours and alternate routes and to control the procession and shall place them before and remove them after the event.
6. The holder of this Permit shall remove all debris incidental to the event from the Town streets, public property and that of abutters to the assembly and dispersal points and route of the procession.
7. The holder of this Permit shall be liable for the conduct of and acts by all participants and partakers in the event and agrees to save and hold harmless the Town of Holliston from any damage or liability, whether occasioned by use of the Town ways for this purpose or from damage to property or individuals caused by or incidental to the event.
8. This Permit does not convey any right or prerogative or grant any permission required by any act or by-law other than Article II, Section 2 of the Traffic Rules and Orders of the Town of Holliston. The holder of this Permit is required to assure compliance with all other applicable rules and acts whether relating to use of State Highways or other public ways or for any other purpose and with all notifications to whatever agencies that may be required.
